### INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING

- ⇒ PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO "AREA 1 MINISTRIES." MAIL THE COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM WITH YOUR CHECK TO: AREA 1 MINISTRIES, 1605 GERMANTOWN PKWY, STE. 111-223, MEMPHIS, TN 38018
- ⇒ TO ENSURE PLACEMENT, PLEASE FAX THIS FORM TO 888.456.6985 BEFORE MAILING IT WITH YOUR CHECK.
- ⇒ REGISTER AND RESERVE YOUR SPOTS WITH NO DEPOSIT DUE UNTIL APRIL 1, 2007.
- ⇒ A \$50 PER PERSON NON-REFUNDABLE/NON-TRANSFERABLE DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2007 TO HOLD YOUR DESIRED SPOTS.
- ⇒ IF YOUR NUMBERS DROP, THIS \$50 PER CAMPER CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR USED TO PAY YOUR BALANCE DUE AT CAMP.
- ⇒ YOU MAY ADD TO YOUR GROUP AT ANY TIME BASED UPON AVAILABILITY OF SPACE.
- ⇒ THE FEE FOR EACH STUDENT AND ADULT IS: (CHECK ONE)
  - ◇ \$220 STUDENT/ADULT REGULAR REGISTRATION
  - ◇ \$240 STUDENT/ADULT LATE REGISTRATION (ONLY IF REGISTERING AFTER THE FOUR WEEK DEADLINE)
- ⇒ BALANCE DEADLINE IS MAY 1, 2007. (SPECIAL ARRANGMENTS CAN BE MADE BY CALLING THE AREA 1 OFFICE.)
- ⇒ LATE FEE: A \$20 LATE FEE WILL BE ADDED TO EACH ATTENDEE REGISTERING AFTER FOUR WEEKS PRIOR TO EVENT.

- ⇒ CANCELLATION POLICY: A FULL REFUND WILL BE GIVEN IF CANCELLATION IS MADE FOUR WEEKS PRIOR TO EVENT (MINUS NON-REFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEE). NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN IF CANCELLATION IS MADE WITHIN FOUR WEEKS

#### May 1, 2007:

- The final balance needs to be in the Area 1 office (\$50 deposit is due April 1, 2007)
- Confirm that each student has filled out an Individual Registration Form with parent signatures
- Review camp guidelines with adult leaders and students

#### 2 Weeks Before Camp:

- Email Excel file of student roster and rooming assignments

#### Registration day:

- Girls and guys luggage needs to be packed separately to make unloading more efficient
  - We strongly suggest color coding girls and guys luggage tags to make this process easier
  - We also suggest labeling luggage with something specific to identify your church
- Fax any last minute changes to 888.456.6985 before you leave for camp
- Be ready to arrive between 2pm-4:30pm

#### Things to bring to registration:

- Medical Release Forms for each adult and student attending camp
  - Copy all medical release forms for your records. These forms will remain in our office even after you leave camp; the actual forms will not be returned to you.
  - DO NOT mail or fax Medical Release forms. They MUST be brought to camp.
  - Attendees at AREA1:ozarks need to have the Individual Registration Form & Windermere health form only.
- Any copies of final changes made faxed prior to arrival
- Balance due for any additions or outstanding balances

#### Items to Review with Your Group

#### Stuff to Bring:

- A fantastic attitude and desire to draw near to God
- Clothes for four days of recreation
- Casual clothing for five days (shorts and pants are acceptable for all meeting including worship)
- Sheets, a blanket, a pillow, sleeping bag, etc.
- Towels and washcloths
- Personal hygiene items
- Spending money for snacks, T-shirts, CD's, etc.
- Alarm clock
- Watch
- Bible, pen, notebook, etc.

#### Stuff NOT to bring:

- Spaghetti strap tops and small tank tops
- Tight clothes that remind you of Britney Spears
- "Short" shorts or skirts
  - Stand with your arms by your side. If your fingertips are touching your skin, your shorts or skirt should be longer
- Bikinis or two-piece bathing suits (unless covered with a dark T-shirt)
- Speedos
- Radio, CD players, ipod, or video games
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol or weapons
- Fireworks
- Water balloons
- Clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.

#### Things We Have An Understanding About

#### Dress Appropriately

- At camp we are all a part of an environment where we are trying to remove distractions so that we can concentrate on what God has brought us there to do. Don't be a distraction by dressing inappropriately. Should you choose to draw attention to yourself by dressing inappropriately, you will be asked by a staff member to change clothes. If clothing continues to be a problem, you may be asked to return home.

#### Damages

- Be aware that you are personally responsible for all damages to any equipment and facilities including common areas and rooms. If damages occur, disciplinary action will be taken, and your group will be billed.

#### Campus
